



## Adult & Scholastic Basketball Tournament Rules

Coaches and /or team contacts please report to your game site at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled game time. If preceding game is finished early your game may start 15 minutes early Teams are not guaranteed warm-up time.

NCAA rules for Open Divisions and WIAA rules for Scholastic divisions with the following exceptions....

1. Teams refusing to go to the court will be disqualified for the remainder of the tournament.
2. Game Time:
  - two, twenty-minute halves (18 minutes running clock; clock stops at two minutes and every whistle there after.
  - One, five minute half-time break
  - Overtime will be a 3 minute period with the clock stopping in the last 2 minutes
3. Each team is allowed three 30-second timeouts and one 1-minute timeout as well as one additional 1-minute time-out per team for each overtime period.
4. Each team must provide one scorekeeper to sit at the official score table.
5. Dunking will be permitted at venues with breakaway rims only.
6. No player may enter the lane on a free throw until the ball strikes the rim. **(Scholastic Division)**
7. Players may enter the lane on a free throw when the ball is released from shooters hand. **(Open Division)**
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct, on the part of players, coaches, managers, or spectators will not be tolerated and will result in **one warning and then expulsion** (team and or individual).  
**Exception: if the unsportsmanlike conduct is excessive, the individual/team will be immediately ejected from the game and tournament.**  
Any individual ejected from competition will be asked to leave the gym immediately and will not be permitted to play for the duration of the tournament.
9. WIAA bench rules will be in effect.
10. **All commissioner decisions are final.**
